Annual Objective(s):

- *Focus* on musical ministry for Sabbath services at start of Sabbath School to the end of the day's program
- *Provide* musical support for special programs throughout the year
- *Assist* with the musical aspect of nursing home visits

Report (looking backwards):

- For the reporting quarter, the music committee has fulfilled its commitment to provide music throughout the Sabbath Day.
- The Committee provides music for Sabbath School and works with the Praise and Worship team to lead out at the beginning of Devine Worship and afternoon programs. The committee also provides music for the shut-ins at two nursing homes, in collaboration with other members of the congregation, on the first and third Sabbaths of each month.

Report (on-going ministry):
