### INTRODUCTION

The LORD is the only true God. The Dictionary tells us majesty is impressive beauty, stateliness, pomp, dignity and shows authority, power, dominion, supremacy, and sovereignty which means God created everything in this universe and He sustains and maintains it. He has total control. That is Majesty. Majesty is a part of the Lord God that cannot be separated from Him. Therefore all the elements that come from this majesty, the beauty, the strength, the dazzling signs and miraculous expressions of His power keep on flowing. You look at them and you might wish you could be a part of these processions and stand up as if you are really great.

But never get fooled for they all just like you, get sick, suffer, have fear of what is happening to them, worry over things in their life, and they die, and people forget them and move on to other things.

But there is One Being called the Lord God who has real glory, beauty, power and strength, and He has life in Him. He is eternal. He only is great. When King Solomon built the magnificent Temple in Jerusalem filled with gold, silver, precious metals, and expensive wood and timber, it was only when the glory of God came and filled that Temple that the people in Israel saw what real glory and majesty was. Human beings have nothing like that and can only try to make things look great.

But God the Lord God is above all. He lives forever and He reigns over all the earth and the universe. He controls the raging seas and storms and earthquakes, and the earth is quiet at His command.
